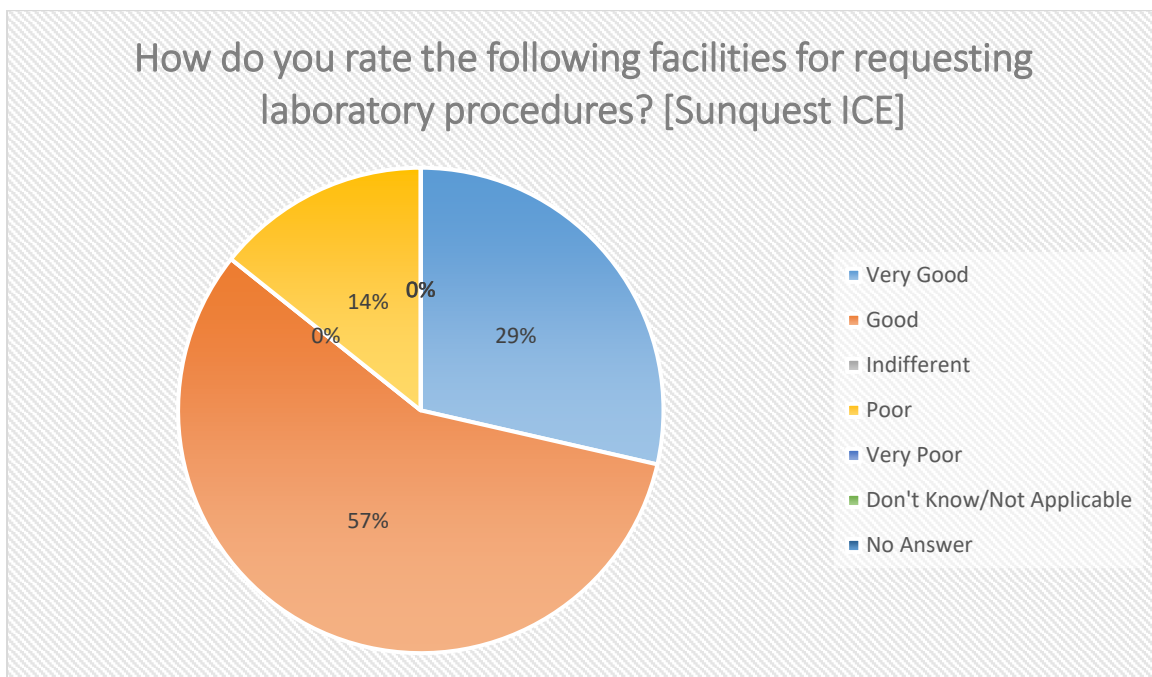
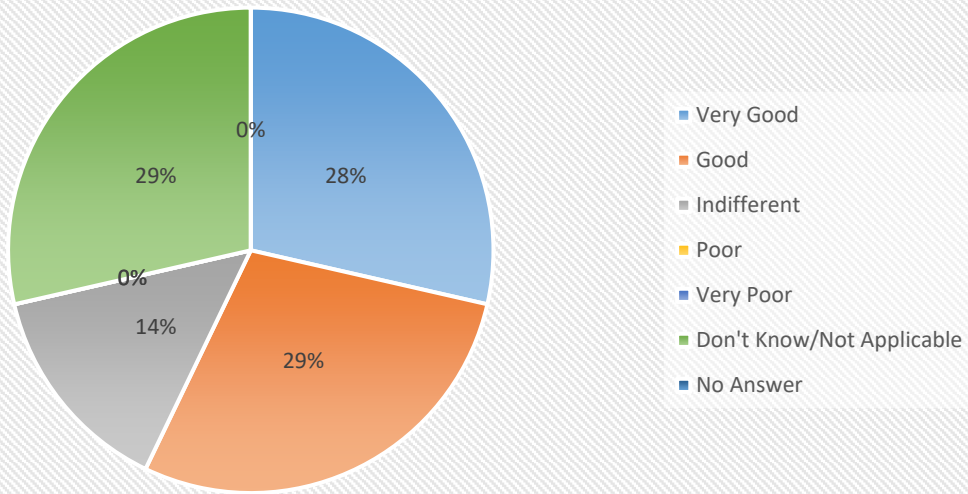


## NORTH WEST ANGLIA PATHOLOGY GP USER SURVEY 2022 Peterborough City Hospital and Stamford RESULTS

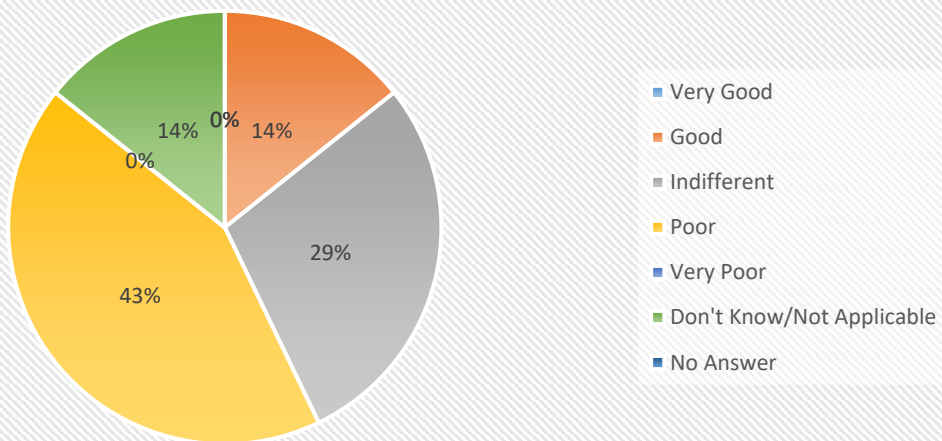
- **GP User Surveys** – findings are based upon the 7 responses collected(over a 5 week period responses from PCH which is a decreased rate of responses the last GP user survey 20 responses from Peterborough City Hospital (PCH) users in 2021 over a 5 week period
  - The Range/repertoire of tests available was rated as good or very good in all of the departments.
  - Responds rated the availability of clinical advice as good or very good
  - 57% of respondents had used the handbook and increase from last year when only 30% of respondents had used the user handbook/Website.
